High School Band Communities of Practice During COVID-19 Mar 10 2022 The COVID-19 global pandemic altered PK-12 school music instruction in 2020-2021. The purpose of this multiple case study was to examine teaching and learning practices in high school band classrooms that were modified due to COVID-19. The research questions included (a) How do high school band teachers approach, construct, and adapt to coronavirus-era music teaching? (b) How do high school band students receive, describe, and adapt to coronavirus-era music learning? (c) How do high school band teachers and students work collaboratively toward building social and musical connections in the coronavirus-era music classroom? (d) What aspects of coronavirus-era band education do participants believe will shape future music classrooms? The research questions and analysis were developed using the theoretical framework of Communities of Practice Theory (Wenger, 1998). Participants included high school band teachers and students. Three high school band director participants were selected based on pre-determined criteria: that they had taught for 3 or more years at their current school with at least 5 total years of band teaching experience. The band students at the same three high schools were eligible to participate. Data was collected remotely and included interviews, observations, and journal entries. Data was

analyzed within each case to describe the specific experiences of each band teacher and student participant. Cross-case analysis was then completed to determine similarities, differences, and unique qualities between the three cases. Themes from individual cases regarded band teacher strategies in remote and hybrid learning formats and how band teachers and students engaged in band camaraderie during COVID-19. Cross-case analysis produced overarching themes; including Responding to Student Needs, Self-Motivated vs. Group-Motivated, Hybrid Band Community, and Predictions for the Future. The data yielded four assertions regarding the experience of high school band teachers and students during COVID-19: the suitability of remote and hybrid instruction for individual music instruction and independence in learning, that COVID-19 cancellations led to flexibility in designing band instruction, and that social interaction is integral to learning in high school band. Implications for the music education field were also addressed.

A Survey on High School Band Director Preparedness for Injury and Injury Prevention in Marching Band Oct 05 2021 It is well established that marching band members are participating at a highly athletic level when performing and practicing their activity. However, high school marching band members may be disadvantaged due to their teachers' limited understanding and knowledge of injury and injury prevention associated with activity. This study aimed to determine if high school marching members in Pennsylvania are vulnerable to injury due to lack of injury prevention. Specifically, the study investigates high school marching band directors and their preparedness to deal with injury and injury prevention. To test the hypothesis that high school marching band directors are not providing enough support for their band members, an online survey was distributed to practicing high school marching band directors in Pennsylvania. A questionnaire with narrative and quantified questions were included in the survey. Questions were divided into the categories of school demographics, band camp, regular rehearsal and injury and injury prevention. The results showed that high school marching band directors are looking for more support to prevent injury within their program, however unlike the hypothesis, most injuries to marching band members happen outside of the program. These results suggest that the potential for injury in marching band exists, however members are more likely to get injured outside of rehearsal or performance. Thus, a high school marching band director needs to ensure proper injury prevention happens in their program to not cause a higher risk for injury.

The research suggests that band directors would benefit from more professional development or professional preparation opportunities to learn more about injury prevention methods within their high school marching bands.

A Study of Utah High School Band Teacher's Perceptions of Factors Affecting the Band Rehearsal Period May 12 2022 The purpose of this study was to determine if there were any differences between what Utah high school band teachers perceive as important skills, activities, behaviors, knowledge, and concepts in the context of the rehearsal and their assessment of the degree to which these i terns ©□were applied during the rehearsal period. A survey questionnaire listing twenty band rehearsal instructional items was used to obtain the data. Sixty-one percent of the sample responded to the survey. The sample included all high school band teachers in the state of Utah. A correlation coefficient was computed between respondent's ratings of the validity of the instructional item to the band rehearsal and the degree to which the respondents applied that item in their rehearsals. There was a positive correlation between these ratings for all twenty items. Some items, however, had a lower correlation coefficient than others showing a lesser degree of congruency between opinion of validity and application.
