AI 2008: Advances in Artificial Intelligence Apr 24 2020 AI 2008, the 21st Australasian Joint Conference on Artificial Intelligence, was, for the first time, held in New Zealand, in Auckland during December 1–5, 2008. The conference was hosted by Auckland University of Technology. AI 2008 attracted 143 submissions from 22 countries, of which 42 (29%) were accepted as full papers and 21 (15%) as short papers.
